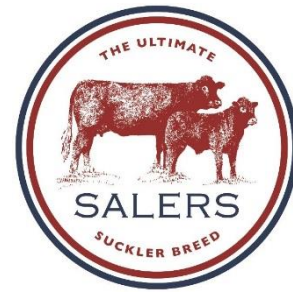

BVD TESTING

All pedigree and commercial cattle being entered for sale **MUST** be from a BVD CheCS accredited herd or have been individually tested BVD antigen negative. All such animals should also be fully BVD vaccinated at least two weeks prior to sale date. Females that are to be sold in calf must be from a BVD accredited herd or individually tested **BEFORE** service, with the BVD status of the bull being determined **BEFORE** he serves females that are to be sold. Cattle not fulfilling this criteria, **WILL NOT** be eligible to enter for sale.

TB TESTING

With effect from 23rd September, 2005 all cattle coming to Scotland from a 1 or 2 year TB Testing area in GB (a High Risk Area) must have passed a TB test within the previous 60 days of the movement. This applies to all animals over 6 weeks of age. If the animals are staying in Scotland then they must pass a further post movement test, which has to be carried out between 60 and 120 days following the movement.

The current TB test cannot be carried out twice within 42 days or false results may occur. Proof of testing will have to be provided by yourself and dates of testing will have to be announced.

JOHNES HEALTH STATUS- IMPORTANT CHANGES

*‘HERD HEALTH PEN CARDS FROM THE HERD HEALTH SCHEME PROVIDER
MUST BE DISPLAYED ON THE CATTLE PENS’*

Following a council decision it is now mandatory for all animals entered for any Society endorsed sale to be as follows:-

ALL cattle entered and presented for sale MUST be from vendors who are

“Members of a CheCS Herd Scheme, and who comply with the current Salers Society ruling for BVD FREE Sales, and have established their JOHNES herd status and are actively monitoring and culling diseased animals from the herd”.

If entering cattle not belonging to your herd, the current health status of those cattle must be declared (an additional herd health declaration to be provided).

Members unable to fulfil the above requirements **WILL NOT BE ALLOWED ENTRY TO SALERS SOCIETY SALES.**

GENERAL INFORMATION

- For any cows or heifers being sold in-calf by A.I. an A.I. certificate must accompany the entry
 - Entries for recipients with full blood or pure bred calves at foot are also invited
 - Any cows entered please state if they have been flushed and how many embryos have been taken.
 - Cattle passports MUST accompany all cattle to the market. Also please state in the case of bulls if any semen has been retained and if so how many straws.
 - All pedigree cattle must be halter trained and wear nose leaders.
 - All ears must be clean & tattoos (if tattooed) checked to be correct prior to inspection.
 - The society appreciates that Salers are a suckler cow breed. The enclosed weight for age should be used as a general guide for the entry of bulls.
 - All Fullblood and Purebred Cattle must have a Non Carrier D.N.A. status for Beta-Mannosidosis. No cattle will be accepted without a D.N.A. Non Carrier Status.
 - All cattle will be inspected and any cattle not of the required standard or displaying unruly temperament must be removed before the sale to another area of the market.
 - Please Note: A cow and calf may be allocated:-
 - a. One Lot No. and sold together as one consignment (entry fee £50 with £40 refunded on presentation of animals)
- OR**
- b. Individual Lot Nos. and sold separately – provided the calf was born before 1st July 2017 (entry fee £100 with £80 refunded on presentation of animals)

PLEASE NOTE: Commercial cattle may enter free of charge

NOTIFICATION OF MOVEMENTS TO BCMS

The auctioneers will notify BCMS electronically of the movements **OFF** the sellers holding **ON** to the market and **OFF** the market **ON** to the vendors holding.

ORDER OF SALE

Following a recommendation from the Council of The Salers Cattle Society, animals entered for the sale will be catalogued and sold in the following order.

- 1. COMMERCIAL CATTLE i.e. In Calf Heifers, Bulling Heifers then Heifer Stirks.**
- 2. PEDIGREE REGISTERED FEMALES**
- 3. PEDIGREE REGISTERED BULLS**

COMMERCIAL CATTLE

There is a section for Commercial Cattle, which will be sold at the start of the sale.

All cattle in this section will be inspected in the pens and must be of suitable quality and standard for the premier sale.

The inspectors may request animals to be removed from the pen for further inspection.

Any cattle not to the required standard must be removed before the sale.

If you are in any doubt regarding the cattle you wish to enter please contact the Society Secretary and an arrangement can be made for a preliminary On Farm Inspection. This however does not guarantee they will pass on the day of the sale.

EXPORT REQUIREMENTS - IMPORTANT NOTE TO ALL VENDORS

It is pleasing to note that at recent sales buyers from Ireland have been purchasing animals to export. We now highlight the main criteria currently required to export animals. Irish buyers are required to make their own arrangements for keeping animals prior to export. The rules are as follows:-

- All animals will require a final veterinary inspection 24 hours before travelling.
- All animals (if >42 days) must be TB tested within 30 days of exporting.

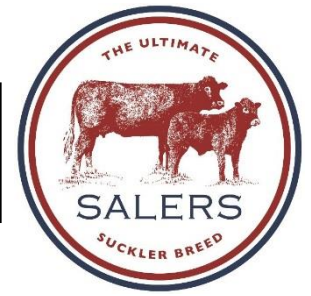
